#### WHIP & REIN HANDLING CLINIC WITH TARA

Club member Tara Defendorf will be on hand Sunday, September 26 for a whip and rein handling clinic. Tara has successfully competed in pleasure driving competitions in the United States and Canada. She may be best remembered for showing her black welsh cob stallion, "William," in many ADS and breed shows. Tara has a background in competing in, instructing, and judging horse shows in multiple disciples. She currently works as the director of an all-inclusive lesson barn where she supervises a staff of instructors who teach people of various abilities riding and driving. When at home she teaches more lessons and enjoys raising some welsh cob foals.

The clinic will be held at Audrey Cooper's farm at 279 East Manitou Road, Hilton, New York, right off the Lake Ontario Parkway a few miles west of the northernmost end of 390-N. It begins at 10 a.m.

This will be very helpful instruction for beginning whips in particular, but all members are invited, with or without turnouts.
