NDS ANNUAL DINNER

Finally! We held the annual dinner, general meeting and auction on March 19 at Barnard Exempts, the venue of our last several dinners. Over fifty members and guests attended and were so happy to see each other and catch up.

The existing slate of officers and board members retained their positions by unanimous vote.

The buffet dinner was delicious, featuring roast pork, ham, and chicken French with baked ziti, carrots, and roasted small potatoes, salad and strawberry shortcake.

The auction was in a slightly different format this year, featuring a silent auction where people placed their bids on bid sheets and kept an eye on them before dinner and approximately fifteen minutes after dinner, increasing their bids if outbid, with the final highest bid the winner. There was also a live auction featuring ever-popular Brian Romeo as auctioneer, assisted by his lovely wife, Jamie, and daughter, Aria, as runners.

Lots of gorgeous hats at this year's auction and they sold at very affordable prices. There was also a lot of nice framed artwork, tea, coffee and wine baskets, a few horse and dog items, books, and an assortment of novelties. Dave Fanton did not disappoint as he contributed several of

his hand-made, heirloom-quality items — boxes, frames, and a bench - for which he is justly well-known, and the bidding on these items was especially spirited.

The auction proceeds were \$1,389. There were a total of 68 items auctioned. Of those, 37 were sold via the silent auction and 31 were sold via the live auction. The average proceeds per item was \$20.43. The number of items auctioned was down, but the average price was the highest that we have seen in the past four auctions. This year was similar to our last auction in 2020 which was \$19.82 but the previous three years were in the \$15 - \$17 range.
